Ian Coleman, Bowelscan Program Co-ordinator for Rotary District 9810 (51 Clubs in eastern-metropolitan area), says, "Bowel cancer is the most common form of internal cancer in men and women aged 40 years and over."

During the month of **MAY** only, Bowelscan Kits may be purchased at a Pharmacy, and returned there promptly after use, which is in partnership with the local Rotary Club. After analysis at the Pathology Laboratory, positive results will be mailed immediately, and negative results by early July.

There are about 12,000 new cases and 5,000 deaths from bowel cancer each year.

Please help create public awareness of the risks of bowel cancer and help add to the 7 lives saved in our District last year".

Early detection of bowel cancer gives you a 90% chance of being cured. Early detection is possible through a simple Bowelscan Kit,
