Hi Philip and Colin

As you know, RC Templestowe in conjunction with ABCD and the students from Deakin University are working on an ambitious children's education support and building project in Lavena on the Island of Taveuni in Fiji.

We have a party of 4 from RC Templestowe plus nine students from the Deakin University Global Citizenship Program going to Lavena in June. Our plan is to complete the building of the pre-school and resource centre during our two week visit! At this stage we have been able to send the RC Taveuni the \$5,100 required to buy all the building materials which is fantastic. We are well on the way to funding the target of 40 children for the year at \$250 each - we have 26 covered so far. The Deakin students are also raising funds which will go towards equipment and resources for the new building and we are applying for District Designated Funds and a Matching Grant to get to the \$15,000 we need for this aspect of the project.

On 1 June we are holding a Gala Dinner at Monte Carlo receptions to help boost the funds and hopefully reach our targets! I have attached a flyer which gives a few more details and a brief prospectus on the Lavena Primary School to give some background info. It would be wonderful if you were able to join us for the evening.

I would be more than grateful if you could let your members know about the event and perhaps encourage them to pop along - we have some great entertainment lined up, the children's artwork will be on display and the whole evening is designed to be a great, fun event. The cost is \$55 including a three-course meal, the entertainment from 4 widely different genres to cater for all age groups and tastes. Thanks to you both for your help and for being such a great supporter of our ABCD venture - I know it's beginning to make a difference to many disadvantaged young people.
