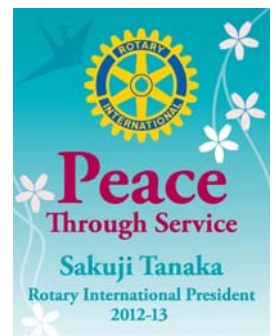

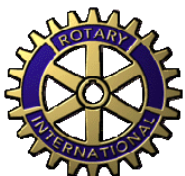

An Australian coaching legend, Joyce Brown steered Australia to three World Championship titles and Melbourne Phoenix national league titles. Captain of Australia's 1963 World Championship winning team, Joyce's leadership and mentoring skills inspired a generation of young Victorian players. Her visionary outlook set new benchmarks for a National Coaching Accreditation Scheme and introduced the first modified form of the game for kids. A member of the Sport Australia Hall of Fame, Joyce was awarded the Medal of the Order of Australia (OAM) for her services to sport.

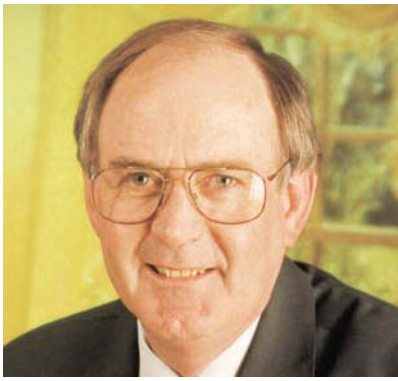

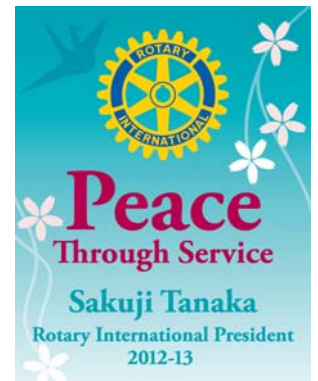

Stall fees added up to \$4,300, coin donations \$1,780.60, BBQ \$556.65, giving a total of: \$6,637.65.

Our club participated in the event on Sunday 18th for the handover of land at Junction Road from VicRoads to Parks Victoria. This section, combined with that area administered by Melbourne Water and the Whitehorse Council section are now combined to give the community a new parkland. Joyce Brown OAM - Administration - Netball

Member of Sporting Hall of Fame
Coach of Multi -World Champion Aussie Netball Team

Joyce Brown, coach of the multi world championship winning Australian netball team, is one of Australia's most successful coaches. She has had an influence on netball coaching from beginners to elite over the last 40 years and has served the game well by setting a number of past and present champion players on the right course.

Ms. Brown played netball for Victoria from 1958 to 1963 and captained the victorious Australian team in the first world netball championships in 1963. She followed her successful netball career by becoming an All Australian (AA) umpire and coach. She graduated from the University of Melbourne as a physical education teacher and prior to her full-time involvement in netball, she taught the subject for twelve years.

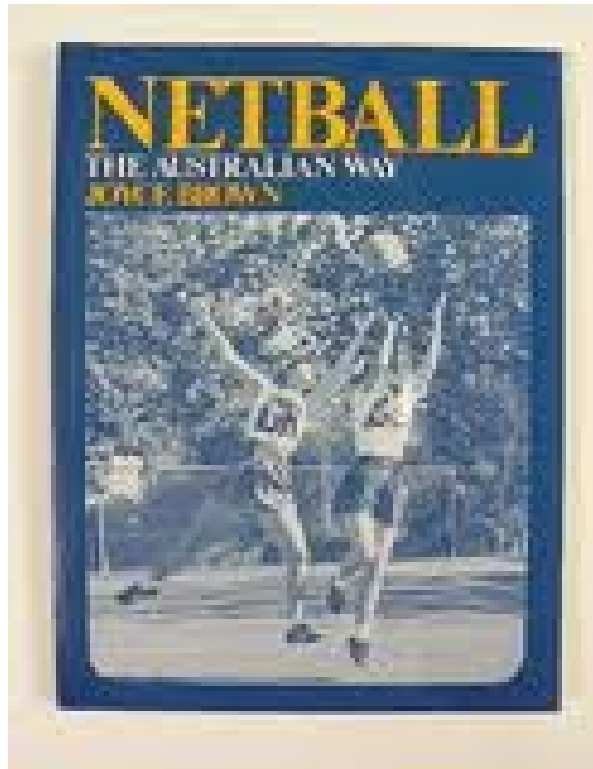
Ms. Brown coached the Australian netball team to three world championship titles, 1975 (New Zealand), 1983 (Singapore) and 1991, and world dominance for ten years. She was also AA coach in 1981 in the Tri Test against NZ and England, and in 1982 she was elected AA coach for the cancelled Singapore tour. In 1990 she was appointed the first full-time Australian national coach. She was the Victorian state coach from 1972 to 1975 and 1979.

- fourth** The advancement of international understanding, goodwill and peace, through the world fellowship of business and professional men and women united in the ideal of service.

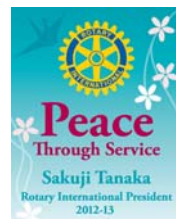
