Whitehorse Historical Society Local History Museum and Archive

The Whitehorse Historical Society maintains a research collection of local history items including documents, photographs, maps, newspapers, oral histories and ephemera tracing the region's development from agricultural to suburban/industrial.

Local history records are available for research at the local history room at Schwerkolt Cottage and Museum Complex on Wednesdays between 10:00 am and 2:30 pm or by appointment. The charge for "walk-in" research (up to one hour) is \$10.



A major industry employing many local people was the Australian Tessellated Tile Company, which occupied a substantial site on the east side of Rooks Road on the South Side of the Railway. In the middle of Thornton Crescent was a huge hole from which the clay was mined to make the tiles and bricks produced in the kilns in the pictures above.

The City of Whitehorse, as we now know it, was previously two separate municipalities each with their own council. The Municipalities of Box Hill and Nunawading.



August Schwerkolt and his second wife Wilhemina.

Migrating from Prussia in 1822 with his first wife, Paulina, August became a naturalised Australian citizen in February 1853. First owning land in Northcote, he purchased land in Mitcham, and by 1882 he owned 88 acres. Two years later Paulina died, and a year after, he married his second wife, Wilhemina.

With his new wife, August commenced building the present cottage on Deep Creek Road in 1885. Within two years, August died at the age of 65 from a bout of Pneumonia and enteritis.

The Whitehorse Historical Society Inc. is a veritable mine of amazing information about the early settlers of the countryside in the Whitehorse region.
